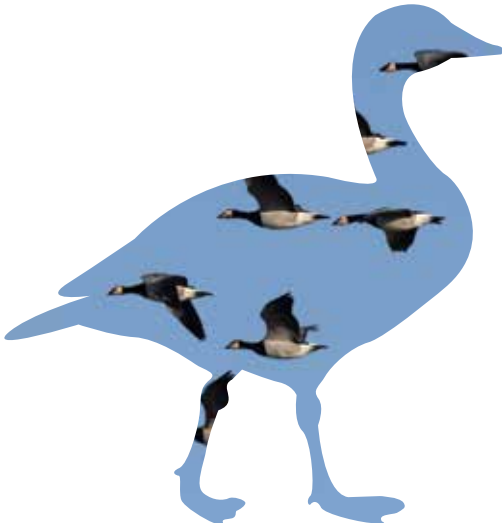

Wilderness Kayak Trip

Explore Loch Ken in our Easky touring kayaks with a paddlesports instructor from Galloway Activity Centre.

Large areas of Loch Ken are designated as internationally important roosting sites for Greenland white-fronted and Icelandic greylag geese. These birds breed in the far north in summer but fly to this area to escape the harsh Arctic winters. They can often be seen at the RSPB's Ken-Dee Marshes Nature Reserve between October and May. Other wildfowl that can be seen include whooper swans, wigeon, goldeneye and pintail duck, whilst mallard, goosander, teal and tufted duck are here throughout the year.

You will see red kites, and possibly red deer and red squirrel and if you are very lucky otters have been seen on the shore line.

Trips take 1.5 hours - all equipment is provided.
